Entry Deadline:	<p>Wednesday, June 15, 2016, 6 pm</p> <p>Late entries are possible until June 24, 2016, 6 pm, unless an entry requires adding a further race division. (an entry fee penalty will be charged)</p> <p>Since the starting field is limited, all last year's participants have guaranteed entry in this year's event. First time starters will be accepted after last year's participants have been registered. We will have a first come first served policy. Please make your entry as soon as possible.</p>
Draws:	Friday, June 24, 2016. Time and place for the draws will be stated shortly before the event.
Jury- and Chairmen meeting:	<p>Saturday, June 25, 2016 at 2 pm in the New Danube Rowing Centre Steinspornbrücke, 1220 Wien.</p> <p>The meeting is mandatory for all participating chairmen.</p>
Entry Fees:	<p>180,- Euro/Boat International crews will only be charged 50% of the fee.</p> <p>NEW: Early Bird Bonus -25% by Registration with a payment deadline before May 1, 2016.</p> <p>Entry fees must be paid no later than June 22, 2016, on the following account:</p> <p>Erste Bank IBAN AT59 2011 1310 0680 5993 BIC GIBAATWWXXX</p> <p>Crews who have missed the payment deadline will be removed from the registration list!</p> <p>Late entries will be charged a penalty fee of 50% of the registration fee. Clubs with more than 2 entries will pay 50% less entry fee for each further registered boat.</p>
Regatta Course:	The Regatta course consists of 3 lanes, and is a 350m straight course in calm water. The organising committee may decide to start on 4 lanes if there are more than 15 crews in a single boat class. After dark, the race course will be floodlit. The race course will be set up with a start pontoon and light signals.



Boat classes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - JW 8+ - JM 8+ - M 8+ - W 8+ - Mixed 8+ (50% men and women rowers) - University 8+ <p>If several teams wish to race in the same boat, please notify the organizing committee as soon as possible. The organizing committee will attempt to arrange the races without overlaps. If one team has no boat available, the organizing committee will help to organize one. Start Authorization:	Due to having only very short intervals between the races, the race committee is unable to take in consideration of multiple starters. There will be no postponement of starting times.
Weight Limits:	Coxes will be weighed in racing kit no earlier than 2 hours before the race and no later than 1 hour before the race.
Changing Rooms:	Changing rooms for the athletes will be provided on site. Athletes can store their personal belongings in the changing rooms at their own risk.
Accommodation:	<p>All participants have the option to camp on site or stay in the gym overnight free of charge. Those staying overnight must bring their own sleeping bags and mats. Regatta Mode	<p>The number of races a team needs to race depends on the overall number of crews competing in the relevant boat class:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 –3 boats per class: 1 heat and 1 final • 4 –5 boats per class: 1 heat, 1 repechage and 1 final • 6+ boats per class: 2-3 heats and a final A and final B • 5+ boats per class: each crew must race a minimum of 3 heats
Liabilities:	<p>We wish to emphasise that all participating clubs must take full responsibility for the medical and the physical condition of all their athletes. All participants must be able to swim and to manoeuvre a boat according to the regulations. Extra caution must be taken with regard to swimmers! All participating clubs and rowers must have liability insurance! The organisers will neither take responsibility nor accountability for damaged property or injury. Change rooms and washrooms in the Rowing Centre must be respected and kept clean. The cost of any damaged property will be charged accordingly.</p>

Award Ceremony:	<p>The Award Ceremony will take place after the last final. The winning boats of each class will be awarded. There will be a special award given to the boat with the best lighting design. To enhance the atmosphere all boats should light up!</p>
Racks / Pontoons:	<p>There are only limited racks available. There will be 2 pontoons set-up: one for entry and one for exit. Please consult the regatta plan for further information.</p>
Safety:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before getting on the water all necessary equipment (race numbers, oars, lighting etc) must be taken down to the pontoons. • Getting on and off the water should be done as smoothly and as quickly as possible. All participants must follow the instructions given to them by the organisers. • Lighting: Each boat must be equipped with sufficient lighting in the bow. Minimum lighting would be a bike light. • With the registration, all participants consent to the publicizing of the start list and results with names and photos.
